## **External tank arrives for Endeavour's STS-126 mission**

## Mating of IBEX to upper stage takes place Friday



♦ Shuttle Update: The Pegasus barge carrying the external fuel tank for space shuttle Endeavour's STS-126

mission to the Interna-

tional Space Station arrived at Kennedy Monday. Endeavour will deliver a multipurpose logistics module to the space station. Launch is targeted for Nov. 10.

♦ ELV Update: At Vandenberg Air Force Base in California this week, the IBEX spacecraft is undergoing testing of its science instruments. The upper-stage motor was spin-balanced on Aug. 7. On Monday , the spacecraft was fueled. Spacecraft spin balancing is scheduled for Thursday. On Friday, IBEX will be integrated to the upper stage, and the integrated stack spin-balanced the following day.

At the Orbital Sciences launch vehicle hangar, prelaunch processing of the Pegasus XL rocket continues on schedule. Mating of the second and third stages is under way. Mating of the first and second stages is scheduled for this week.

The L-1011 carrying the IBEX on the Pegasus XL rocket is planned to depart from Vandenberg Sept. 25, stop in Hawaii, and arrive at the Reagan Test Site at Kwajalein Atoll in the South Pacific on Sept. 26.
